Getting ready for Learning in 2024

Minimum iPad specification iPad 7th generation Requires enrolment in school BYOD program to access network, internet and printing School does not manage or monitor this device

The following are example of devices that DO NOT meet the minimum specifications: iPad 1st to 6th generation, iPad mini or iPad Air 1st -2nd generation 4G SIM card must be removed when using at school.

The Apple Pencil

The addition of the Apple Pencil to our students' digital tool kit enables them to make even greater use of their iPad. Through app integration, students are able to fully mimic not just a regular pen and paper, but all the functional and creative contents of a well-stocked pencil case. This allows digital production of artwork, technical sketches, graphs and conventional mathematical working out. Research has shown that drawing pictures to represent information increases retention of that information. The act of sketching is even superior to other activities like reading or writing because the brain is forced to process information visually, kinesthetically and semantically thus boosting memory and recall by nearly 100%.
