
General Subjects






# Applied and Applied Essential Subjects

General, Applied and Applied Essential Subjects









#### **ATAR Results**

## Where do our Graduates go?

Both ATAR and non ATAR pathway students can apply through QTAC during year 12. 61 offers were made across December and January to our students.

88% of offers were to first and second preferences for our students, allowing them to study in the chosen field as they link learning with life at University.

Top Institutions for our students continue to be Griffith University followed by Queensland University of Technology (QUT) and University of Queensland (UQ)

The most common fields of study were Science, Health (Paramedicine and Nursing), Education (Primary, Secondary or Early Childhood), Engineering and Law.
