Ashlee has been immersed in the dance world for over 30 years, starting at just 2 years old when she took her first dance class and quickly developed a passion that would last a lifetime. She trained in a wide range of styles, including ballet, jazz, tap, lyrical, cabaret, contemporary, hip hop, and theatre.

At 18, Ashlee ventured to Paris to join the iconic Moulin Rouge, marking the beginning of her professional career as a showgirl and French Cancan dancer. This experience launched her into a decade-long career that saw her perform on cruise ships, in casino shows, as a backup dancer at award ceremonies, and at many corporate gigs. She also toured Australia with the revered Cabaret De Paris.

Ashlee's career extends beyond dancing, she also spent many years as a runway model, worked as an extra in movies and TV shows, and performed live on television across France, Italy, and Switzerland. In addition, she built an extensive career in the fitness industry, earning a Certificate III Pilates certification, and expertise in Strength & Conditioning. She also held roles in management and taught a wide range of fitness modalities.

After retiring from her professional dance career, Ashlee took time off to settle down and raise her son. Now, as a mother, she dedicates her energy to teaching and shaping the next generation of dancers. As a dance teacher and choreographer, Ashlee emphasizes strength, flexibility, musicality, and individuality. She is passionate about fostering confidence in her students and helping them reach their full potential.

WORKSHOP COSTINGS

We have an incredible line up of artists ready for our first workshop to be held at Ormeau Woods SHS - Term 1 - Week 10 - Tuesday 31st March 2026. Please see below breakdown of costs for workshop one.

Workshop cost per student \$10
T-Shirt cost per student \$20

Workshop one will be capped at a registration of 300 max for grades 5-9 and 250 max for grades 10-12.

All participating students will be required to purchase a Dance Fusion t-shirt at the **cost of \$20**. This will be a one - off payment for each student. The t-shirt will be worn at the workshop as a way for staff to identify students who are attending the workshop and to provide the students the opportunity to feel like they belong as one. If a student participated in Dance Fusion in 2025 they are **NOT** required to purchase another shirt and can wear their shirt from last year.

Payments will be processed via invoice to each school. Upon registration, each school will provide a completed list of names of attendees and Dance Fusion will invoice the school for the total cost. These invoices will be distributed to your school finance team the week of the event.



FUSION COLLECTIVE COSTINGS

We are excited to expand on our Experience the Fusion branding with Fusion Collective. This event runs concurrently with our Dance Fusion Workshops. Please refer to our 2026 Information booklet for further information.

Audition Number cost per student \$10

Students who are successfully selected and invited to perform in the Fusion Collective Team will be invoiced a \$20 payment to be part of the team. These invoices will be sent directly to the students families on acceptance in the team.

This is an optional add on for all students attending a Dance Fusion Workshop. If a student purchases an audition number for workshop 1 they can utilise this same number at any further workshops they attend.

Payments will be processed via invoice to each school with the Dance Fusion workshop payments. Upon registration, each school will provide a completed list of names of those purchasing an audition number and the school will be invoiced for the total cost. These invoices will be distributed to your school finance team the week of the event.
