In Year 9 to:

- ✓ Increase the percentage of students meeting the National Minimum Standard in Reading to 98%
- ✓ Maintain the percentage of students meeting the National Minimum Standard in Numeracy at 100%
- ✓ Increase the percentage of students meeting the National Minimum Standard in Writing to 85%

In Year 7 to:

✓ Increase the percentage of students meeting the National Minimum Standard in Writing to 92%

Develop a Learning Plan for students who are below the National Minimum Standards in Reading, Writing and Numeracy.

Increase the percentage of students in the Upper 2 Bands in Years 7 and 9 equal to or better than Queensland State Schools by 2017.

- Review student performance data at regular intervals to identify areas of underperformance
- Target teaching strategies to meet the individual needs of students and monitor their performance
- Utilise diagnostic assessment to determine instructional match to improve literacy and numeracy student outcomes
