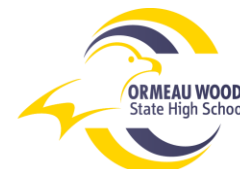

Families of Year 9 High performing students	For families of high performing Year 9 students will have the opportunity to apply for a Variable Progression Plan allowing them to undertake one (1) Unit 1/2 Course over their Year 10 academic year in lieu of 1 Year 10 subject. The intention is that these students will join the existing Year 11 classes and will progress with these classes to complete the course the following year. Benefits of VPP: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Gain additional course credits allowing the best five credits to be used in the calculation of your ATAR. •The opportunity to spread your Senior load over three years. •The opportunity to take a more diverse range of subjects. •The ability to repeat a course to increase your ATAR score.
