Senior Pathways Ormeau Woods State High School



At Ormeau Woods, we endeavour to meet the Education Queensland Strategic Plan goal of 'every student succeeding'. We aim to provide each student with opportunities for success by offering a range of pathways designed for outcomes, including further tertiary study, apprenticeships or workforce readiness.

ATAR PATHWAY

A total of 6 General subjects or 5 General subjects + a Cert III or Higher or an Applied Subject PLUS engagement in external exam preparation, including MOCK BLOCK exams is required for a student to be eligible for the ATAR Pathway at Ormeau Woods SHS.

For students wishing to maximise their ATAR for university entry, we recommend no less than 5 General subjects.

No access to traineeships, apprenticeships or external courses is available within this pathway.

Compulsory subjects are General English and General Maths or Maths Methods

WHO should select this pathway?

Students who:

Enjoy academic rigour

Enjoy theoretical aspects of learning with a high level of commitment to study

Want to gain entry into university courses

Are achieving As and Bs across all their subjects

ATAR FLEXIBLE PATHWAY

A total of **4 General subjects + a Cert III or Higher + an Applied Subject** PLUS engagement in external exam preparation, including MOCK BLOCK exams is required for a student to be eligible for the ATAR Pathway at Ormeau Woods SHS.

Students in this pathway may access traineeships, apprenticeships and are strongly encouraged to complete a Cert III or higher qualification either at school or through an external TAFE course.

Highly recommended subjects are General English and General Maths or Maths Methods

WHO should select this pathway?


Students who:

Enjoy some academic rigor combined with practical subjects

Are still deciding if they wish to attend university or further study at TAFE or the workforce

Are achieving A-C results across all their current subjects

INDUSTRY & JOB-READY



A total of 6 subjects including Applied subjects + a Cert II or Higher.

This pathway DOES NOT lead to an ATAR.

Students in this pathway may access traineeships, apprenticeships and are strongly encouraged to complete a Cert III or higher qualification either at school or through an external TAFE course.

Highly recommended subjects are English Essentials and Maths Essentials

Access to General subjects by negotiation at SET plan

WHO should select this pathway?

Students who:

Enjoy practical subjects and are interested in on-the-job training or work readiness skills

Are already receiving intervention and support for their learning

Are interested into transitioning from school to an apprenticeship or the workforce.
